# Week 2 - Christ being our satisfaction

## **Isaiah**

61:1 The Spirit of the Lord Jehovah is upon Me, / Because Jehovah has anointed Me / To bring good news to the afflicted; / He has sent Me to bind up the wounds of the brokenhearted, / To proclaim liberty to the captives, / And the opening of the eyes to those who are bound:

61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year of Jehovah / And the day of vengeance of our God; / To comfort all who mourn

#### Luke

- 4:19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, the year of jubilee."
- 4:20 And when He rolled up the scroll and gave it back to the attendant, He sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him.
- 4:21 And He began to say to them, Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.
- 4:22a And all bore witness to Him and marveled at the words of grace proceeding out of His mouth...
